GARTH BROOKS AND TEAMMATES FOR KIDS FOUNDATION **SUPPORT THE SASKATCHEWAN CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL!**



Patients at Saskatchewan's new children's hospital will have a special space to play, learn, laugh, and relax, thanks to the efforts of country music star Garth Brooks and his Teammates for Kids Foundation.

Brooks and Teammates for Kids have partnered with the Children's Hospital of Foundation to create a state-of-the-art therapeutic play area for pediatric patients and their families, which will be called the Child Life Zone at Children's Hospital of Saskatchewan. This 2,800 sq ft space (approx.) will join 11 other Child Life Zones across North America, including New York, Phoenix, and Dallas. Saskatchewan's new zone will be the first in Canada.

"We are thrilled that Mr. Brooks and Teammates for Kids have chosen Saskatchewan as their



first foray into Canada,” says Brynn Boback-Lane, President and CEO of the Children’s Hospital Foundation of Saskatchewan. “The support of Teammates for Kids will allow our province’s children to have the very best within their new hospital and we are grateful for the support and generosity of Mr. Brooks, Teammates, and the people of Saskatchewan.”

Brooks will make special appearances at fundraising events in Saskatoon and Regina TODAY, August 26 to thank supporters of the program. While the country music superstar isn’t playing a concert, he will make a gratitude appearance for Saskatchewan donors who help raise funds for the Child Life Zone.

“This is a rare opportunity to enjoy some personal interaction with Mr. Brooks while helping Saskatchewan children and families at the same time,” explains Boback-Lane. “Through this unique charitable donation, attendees will be directly helping build a Child Life Zone and, at the same time, have the chance to check something extraordinary off their bucket list.”

Brooks is appearing at the two fundraisers free of charge. The Teammates for Kids Foundation and Mr. Brooks are also covering the overhead costs of both events, ensuring that the money raised goes directly to the Child Life Zone.

P3 MODEL SAVES GOVERNMENT MORE THAN \$30 MILLION ON CONSTRUCTION COSTS OF NEW SCHOOLS

By using a public-private partnership (P3) model to build 18 new elementary schools on nine joint-use sites, the provincial government is saving taxpayers \$34.5 million on the construction costs of the project, the largest of its kind in Saskatchewan’s history.

The new schools will include 810 new child care spaces as well as new community space. In September 2017, thousands of Saskatchewan elementary students will be learning in these new schools being constructed on nine joint-use sites in Martensville, Regina, Saskatoon and

Warman. These publicly owned schools are being built to accommodate the unprecedented growth taking place in these communities.

“These schools will stay in better condition, be finished faster, and cost millions less than if the government did this project without a public-private partnership,” SaskBuilds Minister Gordon Wyant said.

“I know that students, parents and teachers will benefit from these schools for many years to come,” Education Minister Don Morgan said. “Not only does this investment provide for 18 new state-of-the-art schools, it also ensures that these facilities are maintained in a like-new condition for the next 30 years.”

"The Boundary Dam 3 project has technology which has worldwide application in the push for clean coal power sources and the mitigation of the effects of climate change," Wall said. "We've been promoting Saskatchewan expertise and this project globally and we welcome this opportunity to show Boundary Dam 3 to another group of American political leaders and influencers.

GOVERNMENT SUPPORTS PROJECT TO SEND AMBULANCES TO UKRAINE

The Government of Saskatchewan is providing \$25,000 in financial support to a humanitarian project that is sending donated ambulances to Ukraine to help care for the victims of the crisis and conflict in the eastern part of that country.

Ambulances for Ukraine is a co-operative project involving Canadian citizens, businesses and associations concerned about the political conflict that has devastated Ukraine and its infrastructure. The project has been spearheaded by MD Ambulance of Saskatoon and the Paramedics Chiefs of Canada in response to the urgent need for ambulances to transfer casualties from field hospitals in the conflict zone to military and general hospitals.

“The people of Saskatchewan have a special bond with the people of Ukraine and we stand with them during this crisis and in their time of need,” Legislative Secretary to the Premier for Saskatchewan-Ukraine Relations Ken Krawetz said. “The ambulance project is a practical way Canadians, and in particular, the Ukrainian Canadian community, can help a war-torn country, and I am proud that much of the leadership for this initiative has come from here in Saskatchewan.”
